What is GGP (KUSANONE)?

The Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP), known as "KUSANONE", was initially launched in 1989 by the Government of Japan. It is a type of the Official Development Assistance (ODA) scheme and is designed to meet the needs of grassroots-level communities. Its aim is to improve the well-being of community members directly and promptly. In Tajikistan, a total of 462 projects have been implemented through the GGP scheme, amounting to approximately USD 38.3 million from 1996 to the present.


